Hadhrat Anas رضى الله عنه says that Nabi صلى الله عليه وسلم taught me when I reach home I must greet my family members with Salaam because this will be a means of blessing for me and my family.

SALAAM BRINGS LOVE AMONGST THE MUSLIMS

It is a Sunnah to make Salaam. Nabi صلى الله عليه وسلم encouraged us to spread Salaam amongst us. He said “None of you will enter Jannah except that you believe and you will not be a true believer except that you love each other”. Nabi صلى الله عليه وسلم then asked “shall I not show you something if you do it you will love each other? **Spread Salaam amongst yourselves**”.

Indeed Salaam is a very important thing in our Deen. Therefore it is not recommended to make Salaam only to those whom we know, in fact we must make Salaam to every Muslim, to those whom we know and to those we do not know.

One man asked Nabi صلى الله عليه وسلم “Which [act of] Islam is the best?”

Nabi صلى الله عليه وسلم replied “To feed people and to make Salaam to those whom you know and to those you do not know”.

Anas bin Maalik رضي الله عنه said Once we were sitting with Nabi صلى الله عليه وسلم and He said to us “A man from amongst the people of Jannah will enter upon you”. We all looked at the entrance to see who this man was. Surprisingly we saw a simple man entering the Masjid. His beard was dripping from making Wudhu and he had his shoes in his left hand. The next day Nabi صلى الله عليه وسلم repeated the same words “A man from amongst the people of Jannah will enter upon you”. We all looked again at the entrance and it was the same man again in the same manner.

The third day Nabi صلى الله عليه وسلم said the same words again “A man from amongst the people of Jannah will enter upon you”. Again we all looked and it was the same man again in the same manner.

Nabi صلى الله عليه وسلم could have told the Sahaabah the good deeds of this man that made him a man from amongst the people of Jannah while he was alive, but rather Nabi صلى الله عليه وسلم wanted the Sahaabah to find out.

So one of the Sahaabah decided to follow the man and find out about him, the Sahaabi رضي الله عنه said to the man “I had an argument with my father and he chased me from home, can I please stay with you for three days? So the man agreed.
