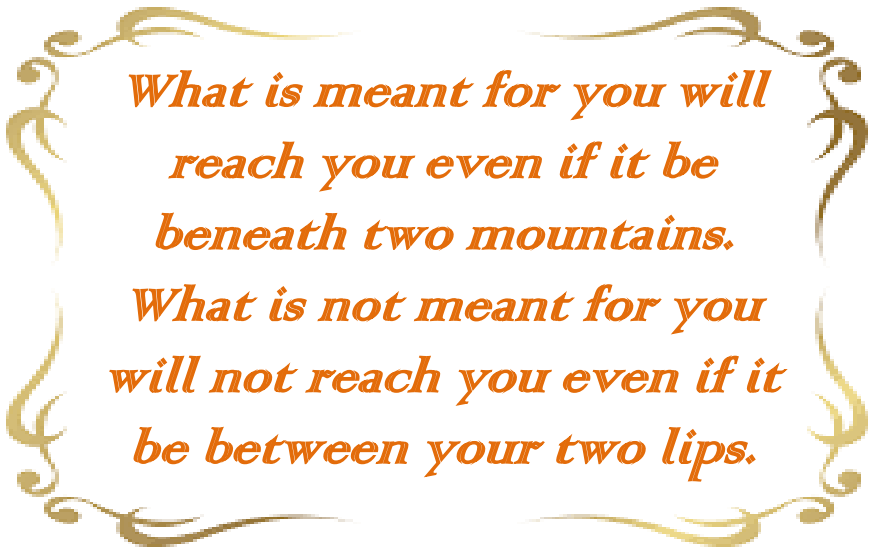

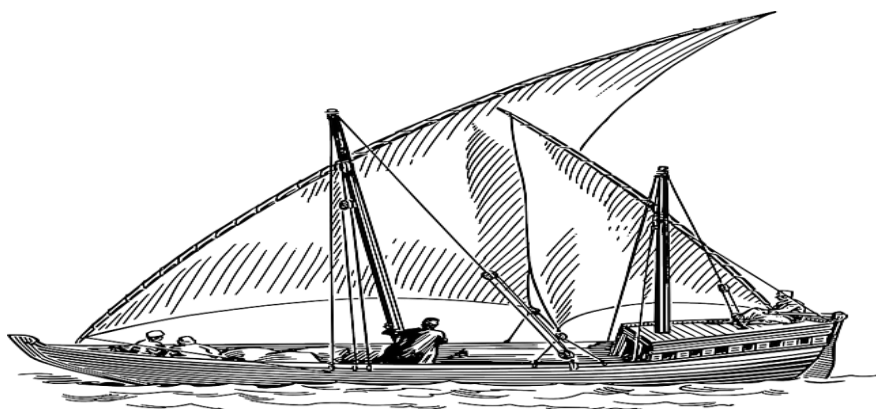
JANNAH PURCHASE FOR ONE DIRHAM
